### **Exercise 1.10: Demonstrating Soft Skills**

This exercise allows participants to engage with soft skills practically and memorably, reinforcing their importance in effective leadership and teamwork.

Each participant will choose a slip of paper from a container. Each slip will have both a soft skill and a demonstration format. The participant will then demonstrate the soft skill selected for the class using only one sentence spoken in role-play, written down, or conveyed through body language.

#### **Objective:**

Demonstrate an understanding of different soft skills through a brief, impactful demonstration.

#### Instructions:

- 1. Each participant will draw one slip of paper from the "Soft Skills and Format" container, keeping their assigned soft skill secret from the class.
- Prepare to demonstrate the chosen soft skill using the assigned format. You can use one sentence only based on the randomly assigned format – spoken in role-play, written down, or conveyed through body language.
- 3. Present your secret soft skill demonstration to the class.
- 4. The class evaluates each demonstration and votes on the name of the soft skill. Based on the class evaluation, the soft skills are ranked from hardest to easiest.
